## Museum of World Culture

This "Ice-Cube" by London architects Cecile Brisac and Edgar Gonzalez was the winning design of the 1999 international competition. The cement and glass building, located on a slope leading up to the Liseberg amusement park, is graceful, compact and modernistic. Its four-storey glass atrium looks out on mountains and woods. It has a complex construction system with very large spans, an exciting atrium with glazed facades and intricate circulation paths. The exhibition halls are in the closed part of the building, facing S odra v agen road. The upper storeys hang freely five m. over a footpath. A 43-m.long section of a display window provides passers-by with a view straight into the largest exhibition hall. The design gives the Museum a robust and poetic frame for its activities. Brisac Gonzales have since then established an office in Gothenburg together with their Swedish partners, Ers eus, Frenning & Sj ogren architects.

## HSB Turning Torso

Based on a sculpture, HSB Turning Torso is a fascinating high-rise building consisting of nine cubes twisting towards the waterfront and the surrounding area. The residential tower is meant to be seen as a freestanding sculptural element posed within the city scape. It is located on the Swedish side of the Öresund strait, right next door to Copenhagen. The tower is 190 m high, with 54 floors of which the first two are occupied with offices. The whole construction turns 90 degrees. Each floor basically consists of a rectangular section surrounding the central core, along with a triangular section, which is partially supported by an exterior steel scaffold.

## Moderna Museet Malmö

In 1901 architect John Smedberg established a beautiful electricity plant building on Gasverksgatan 22, whose glowing gasholder long gave Malmö residents electricity. A little over 100 years later, the building - and neighbourhood - had changed. In 2008 it became clear that the Moderna Museet Malmö would open as a subsidiary to Stockholm, in one of Sweden's most beautiful exhibition halls. It would be time to re-fill the old electricity plant building with art. The transformation mission went to the award-winning architect firm Tham & Videgård Hansson Arkitekter. They chose to establish a new annex - a contemporary addition to the historic building and give the interior an entirely new spatial order. The new annex has a perforated orange-red façade, which connects to the brick architecture of the old. On street level the façade is fully glazed, for daylight. The turbine hall will be separated in three and contains except the exhibition halls a pedagogical workshop.
